Thanks to the generosity of our donors and community supporters, BSDEF awarded **\$20,800 in scholarships** to members of the Blackhawk High School Class of 2026, recognizing their accomplishments and supporting them as they take their next steps toward college, career training, and other educational opportunities.

During the past school year, the Foundation also provided **more than \$2,500 through its enrichment funds** to support teacher grants and assist families in need within the Blackhawk School District—resources that made an immediate and meaningful difference for students in our community.

This fall, BSDEF is awarding **nearly \$8,500 in teacher enrichment grants** supporting innovative projects and programs throughout the district. As we look ahead, we are excited to expand educational enrichment opportunities throughout the district and continue funding scholarships for graduating seniors through your generous support.
